Hills Community Transport (HCT)

What else does Hills Community Transport do?

♦ Information

HCT provides information about local transport options such as timetables, fares and ticketing, wheelchair accessibility and concessions.

♦ Transport service

For eligible clients, if no other options are available, HCT provides a volunteer driver or taxi. A fee is charged. At least 3 clear working days notice is recommended.

♦ Travel Companion Service

If you have not used public transport for a while or maybe never, it can seem quite complex and daunting. HCT provides a Travel Companion Service to assist eligible Hills residents to learn how to use public transport with confidence.

♦ HCT Taxi Money

HCT Taxi Money is a monthly allocation of coupons to assist people aged 65 and over to get to social activities. Eligibility requirements apply.



Mount Barker Shopping Shuttle

The Mount Barker Shopping Shuttle is a door-to-door transport service for eligible residents of the Mount Barker District Council.

Bookings are coordinated by Hills Community Transport (HCT).

Passengers are picked up from their door and taken to various shopping centres in Mount Barker township.

Am I eligible to use the Mount Barker Shopping Shuttle?

To be eligible to use the service you must be:

- A resident of Mount Barker
 District Council and
- Without any other means of transport

Anyone aged 65 or over will need a referral from My Aged Care. Call them on 1800 200 422.

How much does it cost?

The Mount Barker Shopping Shuttle is \$4.00 for pensioners and \$7.00 for non pensioners.

Who delivers the Mount Barker Shopping Shuttle?

The Mount Barker District Council uses a minibus to deliver the service. Volunteers drive the bus and assist with shopping bags.

When does the Shuttle run?

The service is run on Tuesdays and Fridays:

Pickups: 9.00am—10.30am Returns: 12.00 noon—1.15pm

How do I book?

Bookings are essential. You can make a permanent booking or book occasionally.

One full day's notice is required to make a booking. To book, contact Hills Community Transport on 8391 7234.

What if I want to cancel?

There may be times when you want to cancel your booking for the Shuttle service. Please contact Hills Community Transport as soon as possible on 8391 7234.
