RE: Proposed Council Recycled Water Storage Facility – Back Callington Road

Mount Barker District Council is proposing to construct, own and operate a recycled water storage facility on Back Callington Road, as per the attached location plan.

The proposed storage facility would enable Council to supply recycled water to new customers for primary production purposes leading to a range of community benefits such as the generation of employment, both permanent and seasonal.

Council is staging two community information forums on the proposed recycled water storage facility. At each forum there will be brief presentations on the proposed facility and an opportunity for people to ask questions.

It is not necessary to register if you intend to attend either forum. Complimentary tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided.

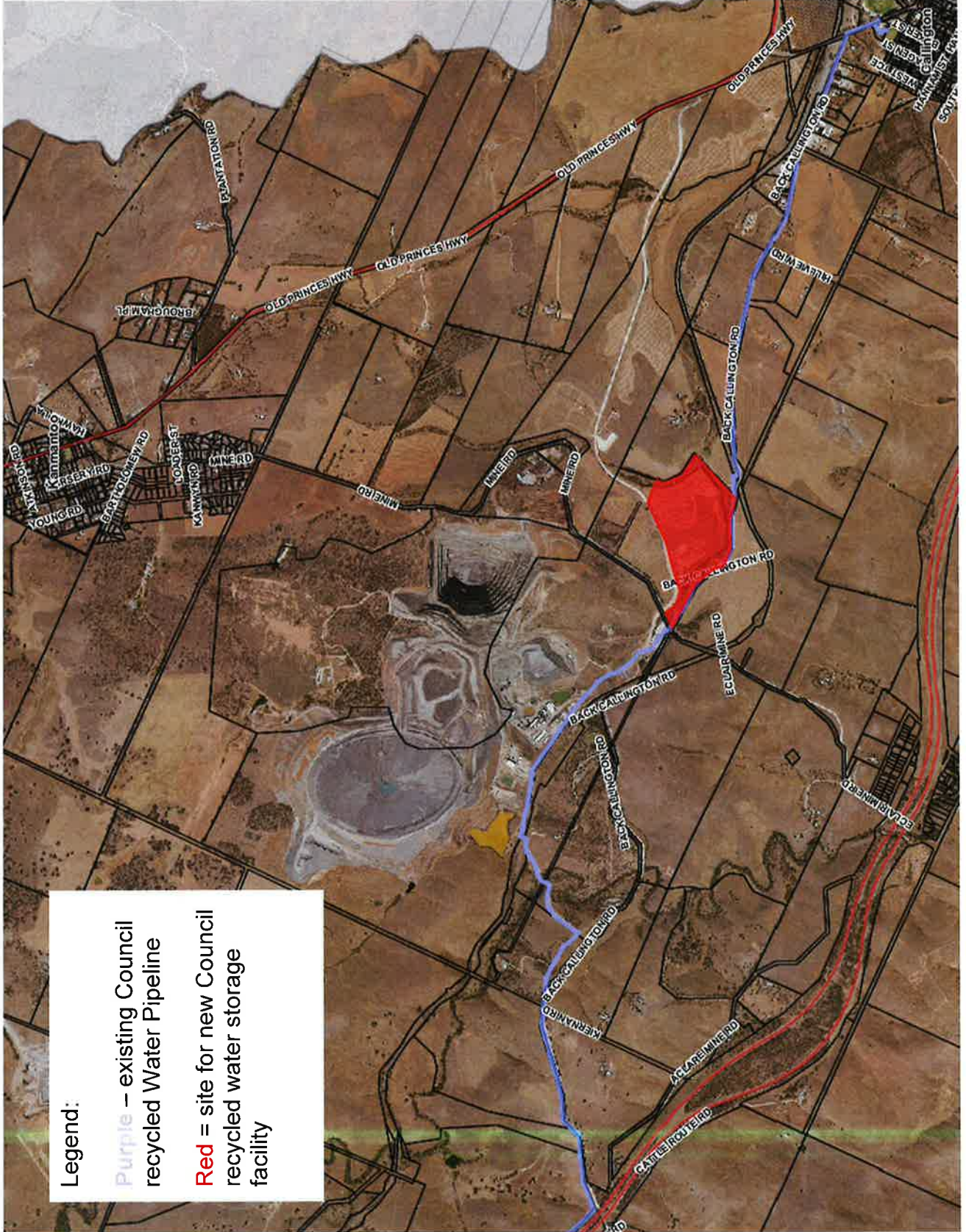
