Council to issue tender for a new wastewater treatment plant

Mount Barker District Council's wastewater treatment plant on Springs Road currently services the townships of Mount Barker, Littlehampton, Nairne and Brukunga, and is the largest council operated wastewater treatment facility in South Australia.

The council has today released to the open market, via VendorPanel Marketplace, the procurement of a wastewater treatment plant in Mount Barker to service existing customers and growth.

To receive notification of the tender release and access the procurement documentation, suitable organisations will need to register with VendorPanel specifically for the category of *Water and Sewage* and any other category that may be relevant to their company.

“The new Wastewater Treatment Plant will have a positive impact on our local environment as well as providing an essential service for existing customers, Mount Barker District Council CEO, Andrew Stuart said,

“It will also have capacity for significant population growth and will support future productive re-use opportunities for the treated water thereby supporting our economy.”
