NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the **'2024 Mount Barker RSL Anzac Day Service'** is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to traffic **between 4.00am and 7.30am on Thursday 25 April 2024:**

Within the Mount Barker District Council area: -

- **Mann Street, Mount Barker** between Walker Street and Hutchinson Street

I direct that persons taking part in the **'2024 Mount Barker RSL Anzac Day Service'** on the above roads be exempted from all Australian Road Rules relating to pedestrian behaviour on roads.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (3) ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I further declare that the **'2024 Mount Barker RSL Anzac Day Service'** to be conducted at **Mount Barker** is a **'temporary purpose'** to which this section applies.

I direct that a speed restriction will apply to the following roads **between 4.00am and 7.30am on Thursday 25 April 2024:**

Within the Mount Barker District Council area: -

25km/h speed restriction

- **Hutchinson Street, Mount Barker** between a point approximately 30 metres each side of Mann Street
- **Mann Street, Mount Barker** between Hutchinson Street and a point approximately 30 metres east
- **Walker Street, Mount Barker** between Mann Street and a point approximately 30 metres north
- **Mann Street, Mount Barker** between Walker Street and a point approximately 30 metres west

I hereby authorise **Fast Lane Traffic**, its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of the speed zones.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the **"SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management"** (which calls up the **Austrroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
