WHAT IS THE POLICY AREA'S PURPOSE?

- To provide open space for informal recreation and limited formal recreation activities.
- The conservation and enhancement of established waterways and open space.
- The provision of pedestrian and cycling linear trails along existing watercourses through the town centre.
- The provision of pedestrian and cycling linkages between large areas of open space.

WHAT WILL THE POLICY AREA LOOK LIKE?

- The waterways and open space act as an attractive natural and open landscape feature within the town centre.
- Established landscape character through the retention and rehabilitation of native vegetation along creek lines.
- The placement and design of vehicle parking areas, public toilets and other buildings that do not detract from the natural setting and open space.
- Small-scale community, sporting club or recreation facilities along with picnic tables, bins, BBQs and lighting.
- Significant vegetation retained and supplemented by additional planting.
