 - Concessions

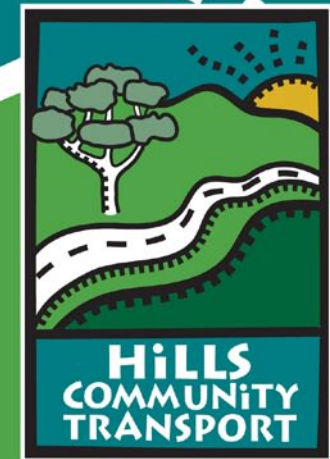
Each talk takes 30 - 45 minutes.

Hills Community Transport

Information about transport services

Hills Community Transport (HCT) is a service that provides information about local transport options.

HCT can provide information about local bus, taxi, coach and community transport services.

Information such as:

- Contact details
- Fares and ticketing
- Subsidies and concessions
- Areas serviced
- Timetables
- Routes
- Wheelchair accessibility
- Eligibility

Anyone can contact Hills Community Transport for free information about transport services in the Adelaide Hills, Mount Barker and Strathalbyn areas.

Transport assistance

If you need to get to a social activity, appointment, shopping or visit friends/family and have no transport we can help you find a way to get there.

For eligible clients we can:

- Explain your transport options
- Assist you to coordinate multiple transport needs and connections to get you to your destination
- Broker transport services
- Provide a volunteer driver if no other options are available. A fee applies.

Bookings are essential for all services. At least 3 clear working days notice is required.

When demands exceed our capacity an attempt is made to re-schedule or prioritise according to the highest need.

How do I register for transport assistance?

If you are aged 65 or over you will need to contact My Aged Care. To register, phone 1800 200 422. You will need to indicate to My Aged Care that you would like to access our services.

If you are aged under 65 you can contact Hills Community Transport directly on 8391 7234.

Who is eligible to use Hills Community Transport?

You are eligible for transport assistance from Hills Community Transport if you do not have any other transport options.

Other transport options may include:

- Driving yourself if you are able
- Family or friends to take you
- Public transport or taxi services that you can access
- Other community transport options

You must also live in the Adelaide Hills Council, District Council of Mount Barker or the Strathalbyn area of Alexandrina Council.

Travel Companion Service

If you have not used public transport for a while or maybe never, it can seem quite complex and daunting.

Hills Community Transport provides the 'Get on Board' Travel Companion Service to assist eligible Adelaide Hills residents to learn how to use public transport with confidence.

A volunteer companion will accompany you on a journey or several journeys and explain how it all works.
