Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will be undertaking roadworks on behalf of Summit Health to improve access to the Summit Health Centre on Wellington Road, Mount Barker.

These works will upgrade the existing hospital side access point to include a pedestrian refuge and sheltered right turn lane for traffic arriving from the direction of Wistow. The other access point for the Summit Health Centre car park will include left-turn-only entry and a left turn/right turn facility for vehicles leaving the car park.

Construction is scheduled to commence in early November 2018, and is anticipated to be completed by early December 2018, weather permitting. In the event of extreme weather, these works will be rescheduled.

The works will generally be undertaken between 7am and 5pm Monday to Friday however some weekend works may be required. Roads will remain open to traffic with a 25 km/h speed restriction in place while workers are on site. Lane and other speed restrictions may apply subject to onsite conditions.

DPTI will make every effort to minimise impacts to the local community and road users and will ensure that access to properties and businesses will be maintained throughout the works.
