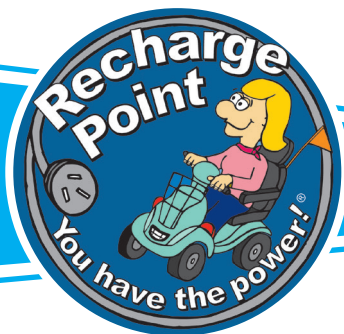


Mobility Scooter & Wheelchair Users RECHARGE Scheme™
